

TERMA A/S AEROSTRUCTURES DIVISION
CHANGES ITS NAME TO
TERMA AEROSTRUCTURES A/S

Effective immediately, Terma A/S and its newly established wholly-owned subsidiary Terma Aerostructures A/S (Terma Aerostructures) will be treated as separate legal entities, and as a result will require a name change on DDTC authorizations. Due to the volume of authorizations requiring amendments to reflect this change, the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Defense Trade Controls, Bureau of Political Military Affairs is exercising the authority under 22 CFR 126.3 to waive the requirement for amendments to change currently approved authorizations.

All currently approved DSP authorizations indentifying Terma A/S will not require an amendment to reflect the change to, or addition of Terma Aerostructures. A copy of this website notice must be attached to the currently approved license by the license holder.

Pending authorizations received by DDTC identifying Terma A/S as a party to the license will be adjudicated without prejudice. A copy of this website notice must be attached to the approved license by the license holder.

New license applications may be received identifying Terma A/S or Terma Aerostructures A/S, or both, as parties to the license depending on which company is involved in the transaction.

A copy of this website notice must be maintained by the license holder and presented with the relevant license to Customs & Border Protection at the time of shipment.

All currently approved agreements held by a third-party will require an amendment to be executed to reflect this name change to add Terma Aerostructures as a signatory to the applicable agreements. The agreement holder will be responsible for amending their agreement. The executed amendment will be treated as a minor amendment per 22 CFR 124.1(d) and must be submitted as such. New DSP-83s must be executed as a result of the name change, as applicable.

Pending agreement applications identifying Terma A/S will continue to be adjudicated without prejudice. Terma A/S may remain involved in certain projects with Terma Aerostructures, and may be required to be identified as a party to these agreements. With the filing of the executed agreement, the agreement holder must attach a copy of this web notice as explanation for the name change or addition of company as signatory, in the executed agreement.
