The U.S. Government views the sale, export, and re-transfer of defense articles and defense services as an integral part of safeguarding U.S. national security and furthering U.S. foreign policy objectives. The Directorate of Defense Trade Controls (DDTC), in accordance with 22 U.S.C. 2778-2780 of the Arms Export Control Act (AECA) and the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) (22 CFR Parts 120-130), is charged with controlling the export and temporary import of defense articles and defense services covered by the United States Munitions List (USML).

New Items and Announcements

- Industry Notice:** Updated forms in support of OIGB time expiration date updates the following forms: DD-2032 (page 3 of 4) 02-21-02; DD-24; 03-05; 04 and 119 have been updated. Beginning Thursday, November 26, 2015, DTAS users must use version 9.1. For forms DD-24, 03-05, 04, 119 and 72, additional DDTC users must use version 4.4 of the DTSP-83, version 3.1 of the DTSP-85, and version 2.0 of the DTSP-83. 04, 119 must be used.

CURRENT LICENSING PROCESS



- Register with DTrade
 - Purchase and install digital certificate
 - Register digital certificate with DTrade
 - Assign DTrade user roles
- Download and complete licensing forms
- Submit licensing forms to DTrade
- Track case status via ELISA and/or MARY
- Download signed license from DTrade



CURRENT CJ & REGISTRATION PROCESS



- Download and complete the Adobe Fillable Form
 - DS-2032: Statement of Registration
 - DS-4076: Commodity Jurisdiction (CJ) Determination Form
- Submit form to EFS
 - Make sure you gather all attachments prior to submission
- Track case status via ...
 - For DS-4076 go to ELISA
 - For DS-2032 contact the Response Team
- CJ Determination Letter will be sent via email

 - add state.gov to “compatibility view settings” for better user experience
- Save a copy of all unsigned and signed forms locally
- Enable JavaScript when completing Adobe PDF forms

What Will Change:



DECCS instead of DTrade

- Defense Export Control and Compliance System (DECCS)
- Single, simple online interface
- Government cloud with improved availability

Improved Security:

- Logon/Password
- Digital Certificate
- Multiple layers of technology
- Secure online [Pay.gov](https://pay.gov)

Better User Experience (UX):

- Browser based web application vs form fill/file/submit
- Ability to copy submissions
- Required data fields indicated
- Dashboard to track work items
- Industry homepage
- Anonymous User Access

Streamlined Processes

- Consolidate data collection down to 4 forms w/new numbers
